After having pre-registered, dancers should plan to arrive at the studio no less than 15 minutes before their audition time, to check in, complete any remaining paperwork (an application should be fully completed ahead of time, along with headshot – please fill out thoughtfully so we can get to know your dancer), and to warm up. Dancers should wear their best hip hop attire to auditions.

Light makeup and hair accessories are acceptable. Dancers will learn a short combo. and will be asked to freestyle, as part of their audition.

AUDITION RESULTS

Evaluation:

The Dance Spot will bring in outside judges to help evaluate auditioning dancers, and provide objective feedback for team placement. In addition, director feedback is considered, as well as past attendance, work ethic, attitude and performance quality (for returning company members). Judges and directors will share feedback after auditions and collaborate to determine the crew best suited to dancers' abilities, commitment level and expressed goals (per their application).

Results:

Dancers will be notified on the evening of May 22nd, via email, of their audition results/placement. After that, one parent and dancer are REQUIRED to attend a mandatory crew meeting with the director on May 24th.

Summer classes start Monday, June 3rd, and end on Saturday, July 27th. The fall session begins on Monday, August 19th.

Attendance Policy: Students are not allowed to have more than 3 absences per class per semester. All absences must be approved by the director prior to classes missed. All conventions and competitions are mandatory. No exceptions. Reblocking fees of \$150/piece will apply.
